

Pharmacists in New Mexico

Have been safely prescribing all FDAapproved tobacco cessation products since 2004

A study including >14,000 participants

Showed pharmacist-provided smoking cessation interventions have quit rates on par with other health care professionals



Ten US states

Allow pharmacists to prescribe all FDA-approved tobacco cessation products – including bupropion and varenicline

Seven US states

Allow pharmacists to prescribe NRT only however the combination of bupropion or varenicline with NRT is more effective than monotherapy with any of these medications
